



Western Power Contractor Connect Scheme



OVERVIEW

This non-accredited course is designed for Western Power accredited electrical contractors and authorised electrical workers undertaking “Energising the Installation” tasks.

The course focuses on the practical aspect of testing and connecting service connections. Various training aids and activities are included in the course (e.g. live connections) to enable participants to directly apply the knowledge gained in the workplace.

REQUIREMENTS

Students need to hold a current WA Unrestricted Electrician’s Licence or equivalent issued in an Australian State or Territory.

Prior to enrolment students should contact Western Power Inspection Services branch on (08) 9359 7552 to determine eligibility for entry.

CONTENT

- Identify the requirements of and the legislative requirements applicable to the Contractor Connect Scheme
- Perform installation testing and verification
- Perform pillar connections
- Perform meter connections, testing and sealing
- Identify the Multiple Earth Neutral (MEN) connection requirements
- Identify the administrative requirements including auditing, refresher training and notices.
