OVERVIEW

This nationally accredited course is approved by Building and Energy WA and provides the Minimum Australian Context Gap training to holders of an Offshore Technical Skills Record (OTSR) for the UEE30811 Certificate III in Electrotechnology Electrician qualification. The course enables electricians to attain the necessary requirements to apply an unrestricted WA Electrician's Licence from the Electrical Licensing Board.

REQUIREMENTS

Entrants to this course must:

- Hold an Offshore Technical Skills Record (OTSR) for a UEE30811 Certificate III in Electrotechnology Electrician (or successor)
- Hold a provisional/restricted licence issued by the regulatory authority responsible for regulating electrical work and licensing of workers in the jurisdiction where the training will take place

- Be engaged (employed) as an electrical worker or have access to a workplace environment that replicates workplace conditions
- Hold a certificate of currency for resuscitation (CPR) within the last twelve months and can provide a certificate of currency

CONTENT

DURATION

The program is typically delivered over a period of 4 weeks.

Candidates have a maximum period of 12 months in which to complete the 'on-the-job' component.
