Perform rescue from a live low voltage panel and CPR



OVERVIEW

This nationally accredited course provides participants with the training skills and knowledge to perform rescue procedures from live low voltage (LV) apparatus, not including overhead lines and underground cables, in the work place. It specifies the mandatory requirements of rescue from a live LV panel and how they apply in the context of transmission, distribution and rail work functions.

This course also provides the skills and knowledge required to perform cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR) in line with the Australian Resuscitation Council [ARC] Guidelines.

REQUIREMENTS

A current WA 'Unrestricted Electricians Licence' or its equivalent issued in an Australian state or territory or:

- **UEECD0007** Apply work health and safety regulations, codes and practices in the workplace statement of attainment; or
- **UETDREL006** Work safely in the vicinity of live electrical apparatus as a non-electrical worker statement of attainment.
